The COST Action Justice360 hereby invites applications for a Virtual Mobility Grant. Virtual Mobility Grants allow research to build capacity and improve virtual collaborations in ways that help deliver the overall objectives of the Action. Justice360 offers one Virtual Mobility Grant to take place before the end of September 2023 so that the activity can be accounted for before the end of October of this year. The Virtual Mobility Grant has a maximum award of 1450 euro. To be eligible for a Virtual Mobility, applications have to live up to the criteria below.

Award criteria:

- The grant is open to all Action participants with a primary affiliation to an institution located in a COST Full or Cooperating Member country and to MC Observers from a COST Near Neighbour Country.
- The applicant will participate actively in virtual activity in the host institution, including by presenting a paper on research related to Justice360.
- The applicant has a viable working plan that relates both to the Justice360 Action and to the research conducted at the host institution.
- Virtual Mobility strengthens the career profile of the applicant.
- The Virtual Mobility has concrete outputs and contributes to the MoU of Justice360, its objectives and deliverables.
